Without a local facility, there is a real worry that thoughtless individuals are tempted to dump rubbish instead of taking it to local site.

Botwell Green Leisure Complex

The new swimming pool, fitness centre and library are due to be completed early in the New Year. Although your Labour Community Councillors welcome the new development, there are continuing issues regarding how the new facilities will affect traffic and parking in Hayes.

Lynne, Tony and Robin have been involved in resolving problems with the development which affected the Bowls Club. However, they understand that further changes to planning matters are expected. They are determined to ensure that you, as Townfield residents, receive the best possible new building and facilities without suffering from extra traffic congestion and full car parks.

Festive Lights, Children's Reflectors and More

Your Labour Councillors have allocated part of the ward budget towards improving the festive lights both in Hayes Town centre and extending along Coldharbour Lane. Another amount is being used to provide winter reflector packs for every primary school child attending a Townfield school. Each child should receive their pack soon after returning to school this term.

Further proposals for the balance of the fund include fencing around "The Hillingdon Badge" as well as restoring the floral displays in various locations in Townfield.

Lynne, Tony and Robin have listened to the priorities of Townfield residents to make the most of the limited funds available. People have said that they would like the money to make life better and safer for everybody.
