Savage Tory Cuts Hit Your Safety & Your Children's Schools

Tory Leader Scraps New Schools for Hillingdon

The Leader of Hillingdon Council, Conservative Councillor Puddifoot, addressed an assembly of all the local secondary head teachers to inform them that he was refusing to sign up to the Government's £150 million investment programme (Building Schools for the Future) to modernise and rebuild the secondary schools in Hayes and the south of the borough.

The council leader has stood down virtually all of the expert team of officers that have been engaged for two years in preparing the plans for the investment programme.

Hayes and Harlington MP John McDonnell is furious that the Conservative council has blocked £150 million being invested in schools in his constituency.

Leader of the Labour Group Councillor Mo Khursheed commented "we are all devastated after the unilateral announcement by the Conservative leader of the council."

The Successful School That The Tories Wanted To Demolish

In the early 1990's the Conservative administration of the council closed the original Barnhill School on the grounds that it was not needed. The parents of the 1400 pupils who now attend the school may beg to differ. When Labour came to power in Hillingdon they immediately started work on plans not only to re-open it but to re-build it with modern state of the art facilities. This investment coupled with the hard work of teachers has created an environment in which pupils can thrive. **This year The School has been officially recognised as the most improved school in London.** This follows its outstanding success in achieving a 92% increase in the number of school students achieving at least 5 GCSE A*-C grades (inc. English and Maths).

Tories argue that they have changed. But do they really care about the education of our children? In the last few weeks they have decided not to even bother bidding for government money to invest in school facilities across Hillingdon.

The lesson is simple.

Tories see education as a cost.

Labour sees it as an investment in all of our children's futures.
